Re: **New Primary Care OHIP Payment and Roster Reports**

New Reports Available in April 2015

The Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (ministry) is improving the payment and roster reporting services to all physicians in Patient Enrolment Models (PEMs) through the introduction of the following two (2) new electronic reports:

- A **Roster & Capitation Payment Reconciliation** e-report for individual physicians that will provide a monthly roster and combine capitation payment and reconciliation information currently provided on six (6) existing paper reports (dependent on your Patient Enrolment Model).

These paper reports will no longer be available once the new e-report is implemented.

- An **OHIP Payment Summary** e-report for Group leads that will provide new summary information related to Group and individual physician payments to assist with monthly reconciliation and disbursement of physician payments.



Existing Reporting

The monthly Remittance Advice and Outside Use Report (patients with signed consent) are not impacted with this implementation. You will continue to receive these reports in the same manner you currently do.

With the implementation of the ***Roster & Capitation Payment Reconciliation*** e-report the following paper reports are being discontinued:

- Base Rate and Comprehensive Care and Complex Capitation Payment Reconciliation Detail Report - PCCP41R1 (BR)
- Base Rate, Comprehensive Care and Complex Capitation Payment Detail Report / Comprehensive Care and Complex Capitation Payment Details Report / Comprehensive Care Capitation Payment Detail Report – PCCP05R2
- Comprehensive Care Capitation Payment Reconciliation Detail Report - PCCP41R2
- Comprehensive Care and Complex Capitation Payment Reconciliation Detail Report – PCCP41R3
- Enrolment Report – Patient Detail - PCRP60R1-E (ED)
- Enrolment Report – Patient Summary - PCRP60R1-E (ES)

Training

The ministry will be offering an on-line e-Guide to demonstrate the new Primary Care reports and to assist physicians and their staff in the adoption of the electronic reports. The e-Guide will be available to physicians and staff just prior to the delivery of the new reports.

Access to the New Reports

PEM physicians will access the e-reports using the new Medical Claims Electronic Data Transfer (MC EDT) services.

MC EDT will allow you to:

1. View the formatted e-report using your computer's Internet browser.
2. Download the formatted e-report into an office tool (e.g. Excel).
3. Have the e-report information automatically integrated into your CMS/EMR tools.
